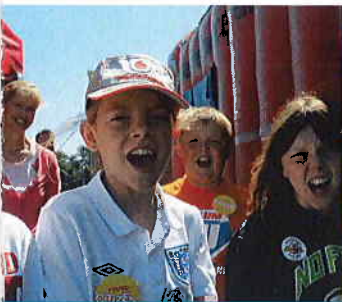

About the Partnership...

The Wyre Forest Community Safety Partnership sees the council, the police and other agencies working closely together to ensure that Wyre Forest remains a safe place to live, work or visit.

Such partnerships exist across the country. They were set up as a result of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998. This placed a statutory requirement on local authorities to form Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnerships (CDRPs) to work together to reduce re-offending, tackle crime, anti social behaviour, environmental issues and the harm caused by drugs and alcohol in their local districts. These are now called Community Safety Partnerships, or CSPs.

The partnership tackles issues which residents, businesses and visitors say are important to them. There is a joined up approach, rather than people having to deal with several bodies at the same time about the same problem.

The partnership works to make the community safer, to reduce crime and the fear of crime, to reduce anti-social behaviour and to work with the local community.

Projects...

Throughout the year, the Wyre Forest Community Safety Partnership works on a number of projects to benefit the local community.

Just some of the projects we have been involved in have included setting up the Home Security Scheme, carrying out seasonal crime prevention campaigns and providing holiday activities for young people.

The projects we get involved in are extremely wide ranging and address community issues and concerns. Our projects are all centred on community safety and ensuring the Wyre Forest remains a place where people are safe and feel safe.
